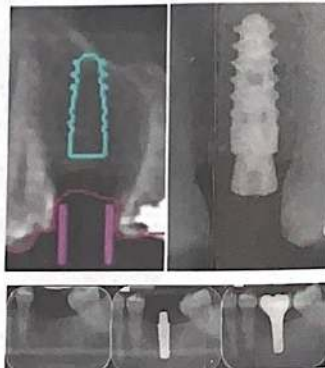

YORKSHIRE GALLSTONE CLINIC

Did you know that one in 10 adults are thought to have gallstones in the UK?

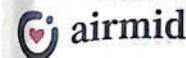
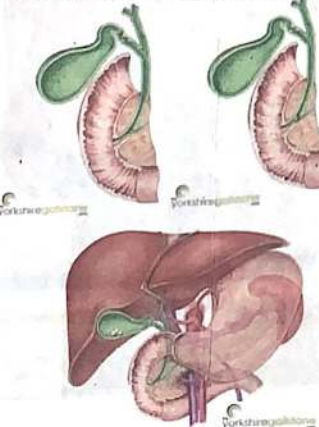
Being female and having a family history of gallstones are significant risk factors for developing gallstones. Among the many functions of the liver is that it makes about half a litre of bile a day, which is stored in the gallbladder. When food enters the stomach, a hormone is released by the stomach wall which causes the gallbladder to squeeze and push bile down into the intestine to mix with food as it leaves the stomach. Bile is a detergent and helps break down fatty food. If gallstones are present, they can move to the exit site after eating fatty food and get stuck in the cystic duct. This causes intense pain. The pain is often in the right upper part of the abdomen and can radiate through to the back. Gallstones can sometimes pass down the bile duct and cause jaundice and pancreatitis. The best treatment for someone with gallstone symptoms is to have their gallbladder removed with a laparoscopic cholecystectomy. This is usually a day case and recovery is between two days and three weeks.
